Coastal Empire Montessori surpasses state average on CCRPI

SAVANNAH, Ga. – The Georgia Department of Education (GADoE) has published the 2014 CCRPI Reports. The score for Coastal Empire Montessori Charter School (CEMCS) increased **12.2 points** from 61.6 in 2013 to 73.8 in 2014.

This jump places Coastal Empire Montessori above the statewide average of 72.6 points. While the CCRPI average for Georgia elementary schools has decreased since 2012, CEMCS's performance has grown. CEMCS's performance also surpassed that of the SCCPSS elementary schools, which averaged 68.7 points.

The CCRPI is a "comprehensive school improvement, accountability, and communication platform for all educational stakeholders that will promote college and career readiness for all Georgia public school students." (GADoE)
