Coastal Empire Montessori surpasses state and local averages on CCRPI

SAVANNAH, Ga. – The Georgia Department of Education has published the 2016 College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) Reports and Coastal Empire Montessori Charter School has surpassed both the state and local average scores.

Coastal Empire Montessori is a K through 5th grade elementary school that has served the students and parents of Chatham County since 2008. Earning a CCRPI score of 74.4 points in 2016 places the school above the state elementary average of 71.7 and the local district elementary average of 61.8.

The school's staff and Board of Trustees feel that these results are continued proof that non-traditional classroom environments can provide increased student achievement when effective strategies and practices are implemented.
